

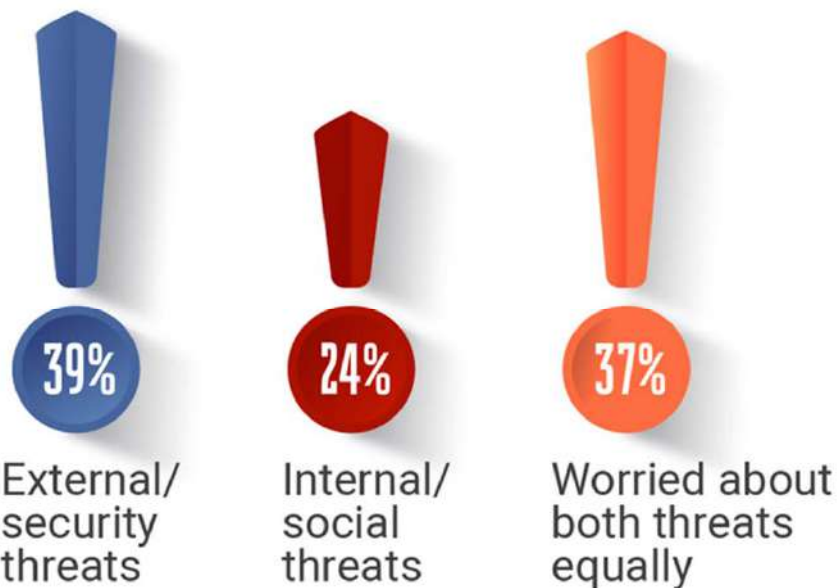

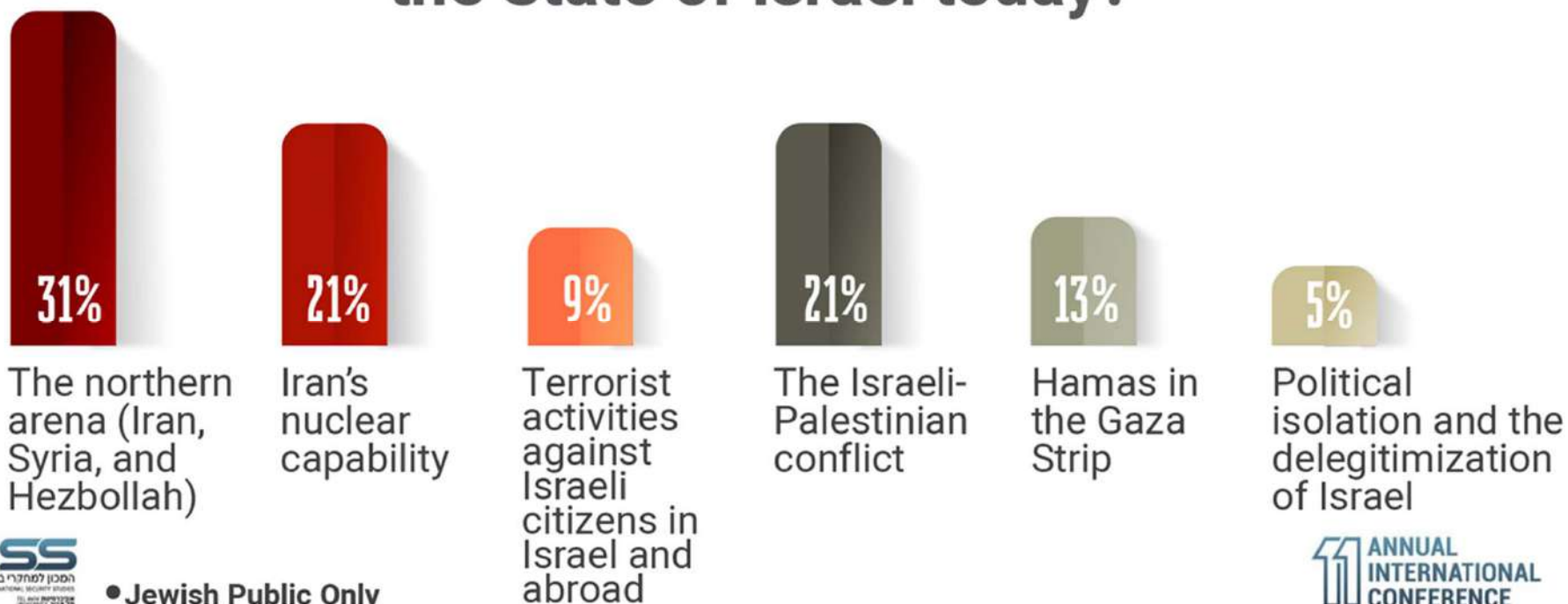

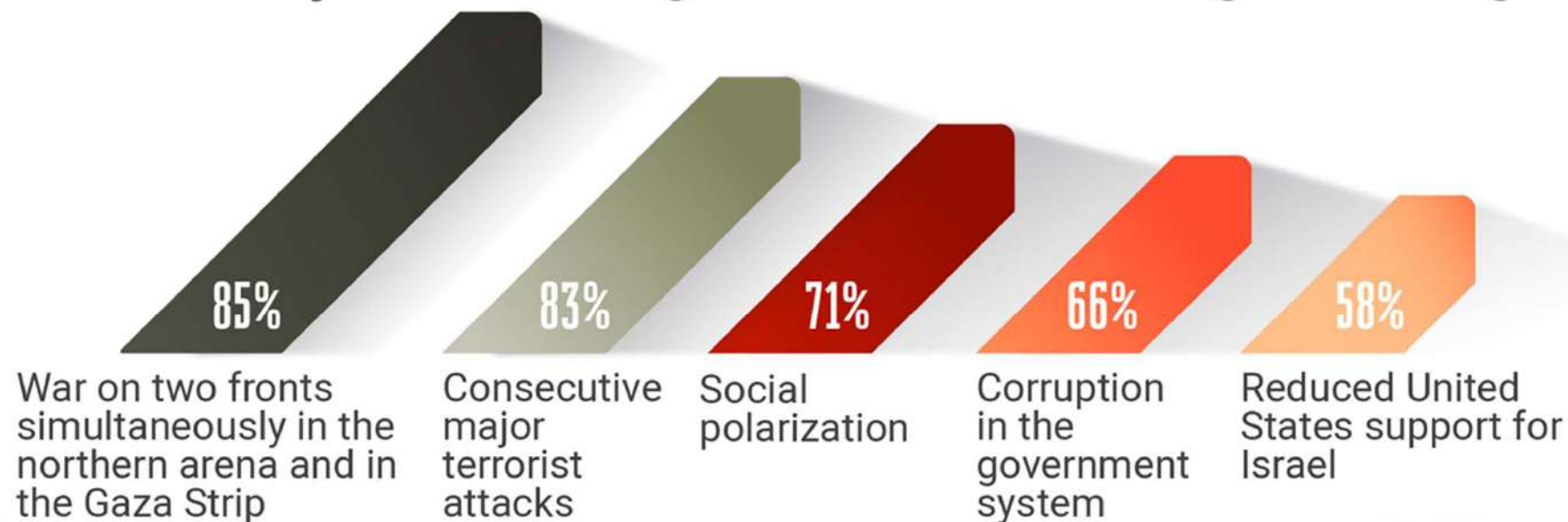
Are you more worried about the external/security threats to Israel or about the internal/social threats?



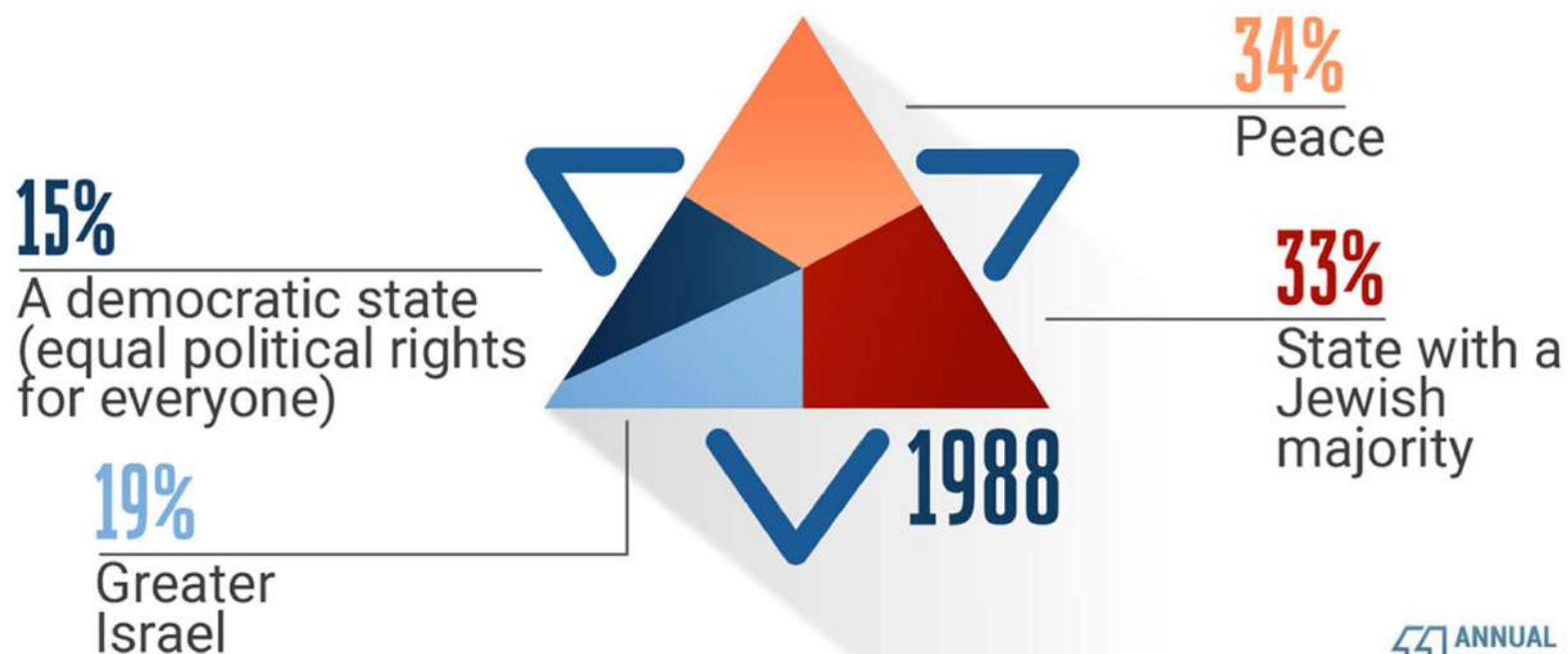
What is the gravest external threat to the State of Israel today?



Will the State of Israel be capable of successfully contending with the following challenges?



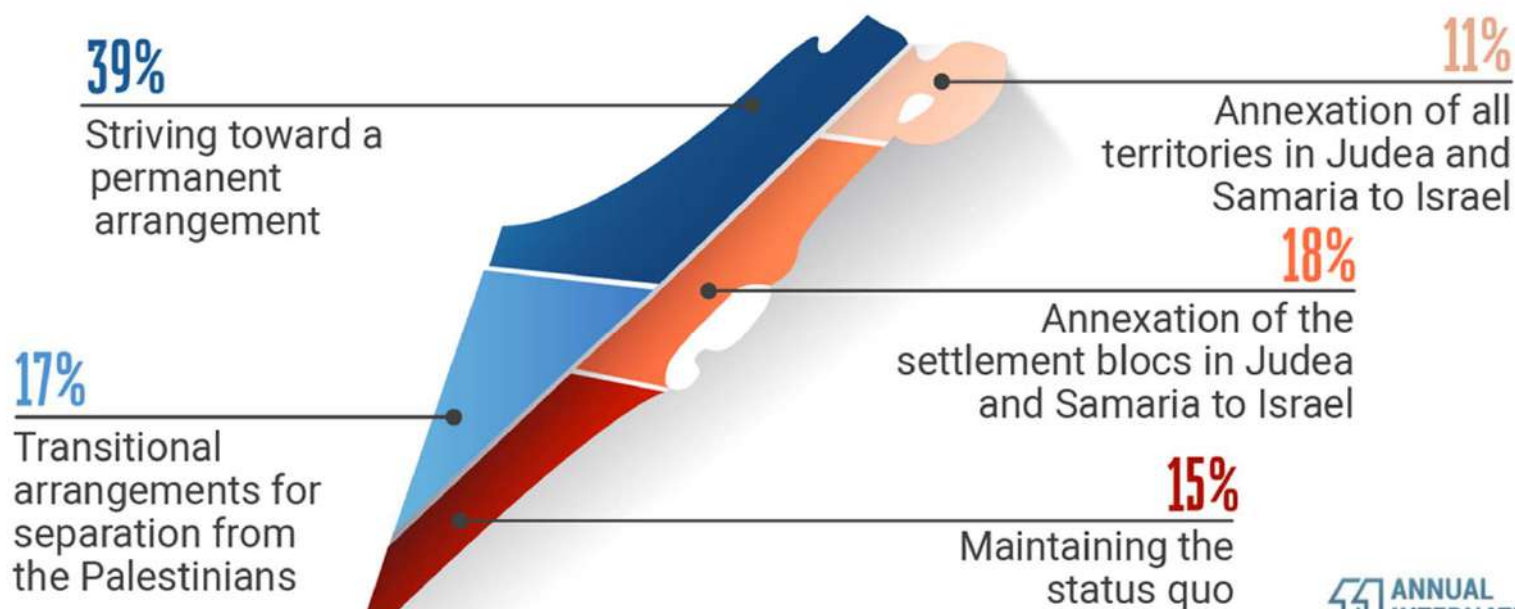

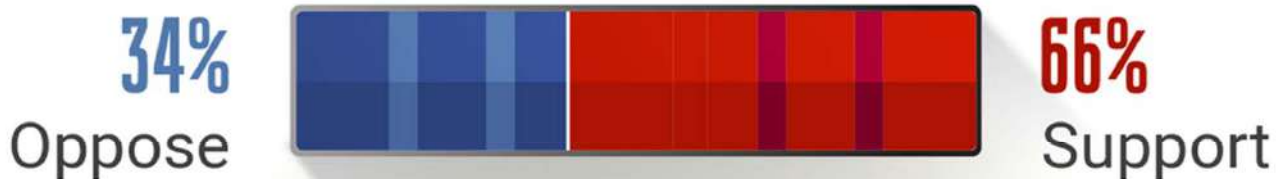

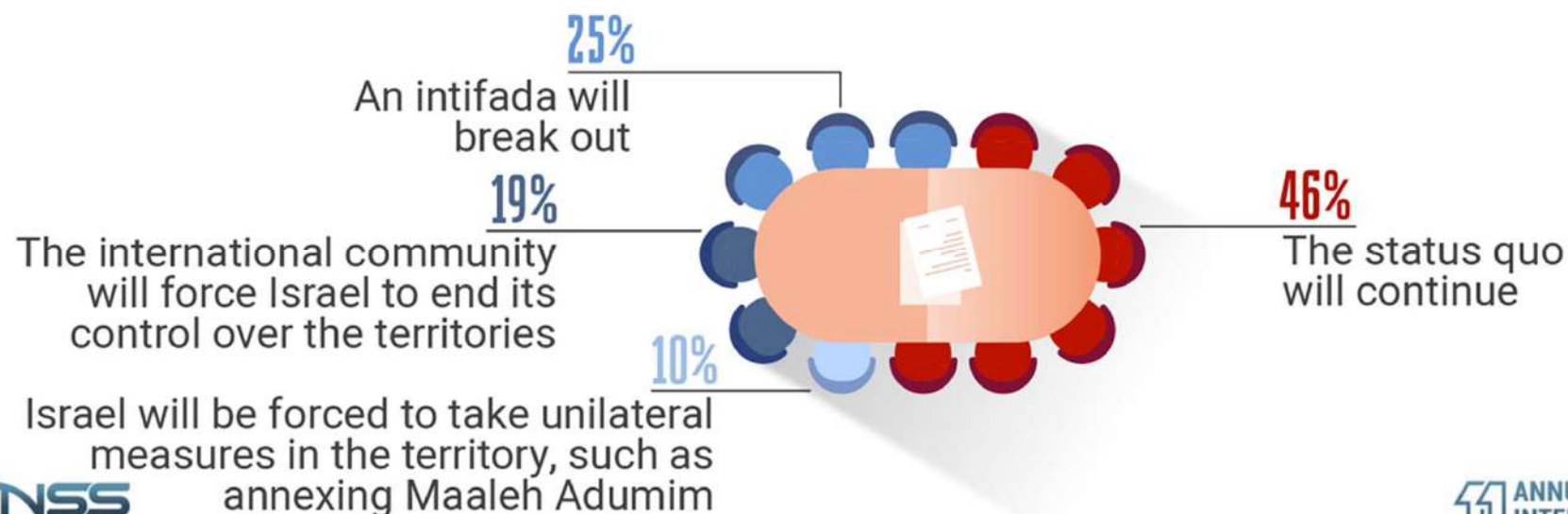

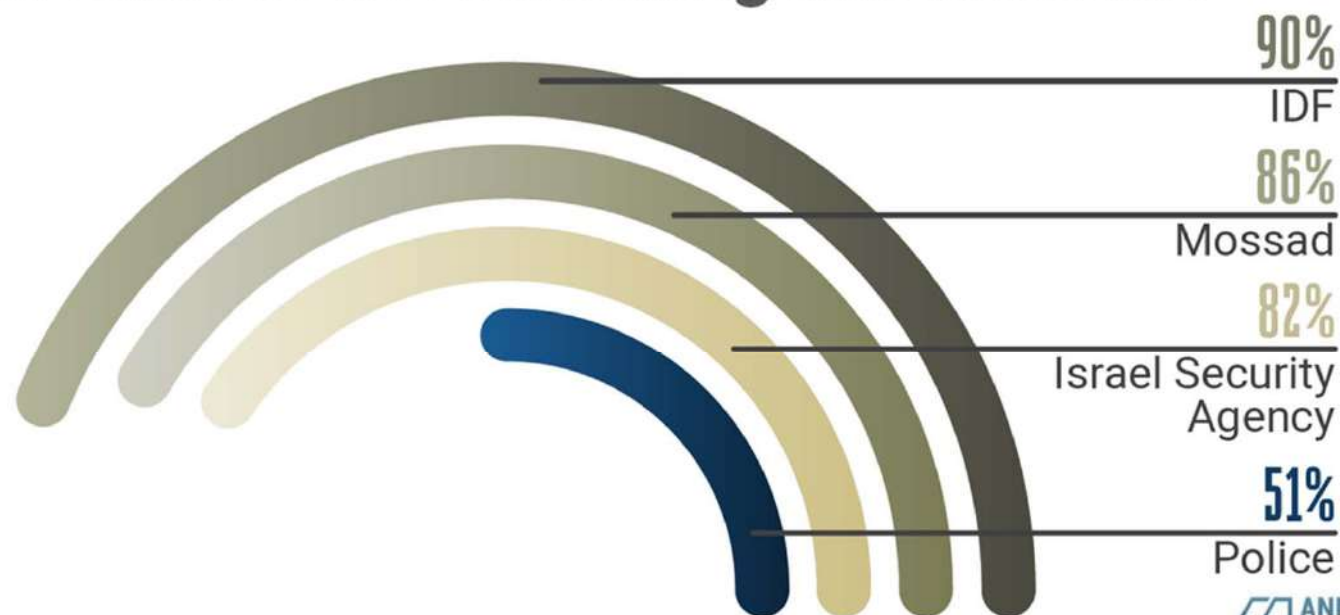

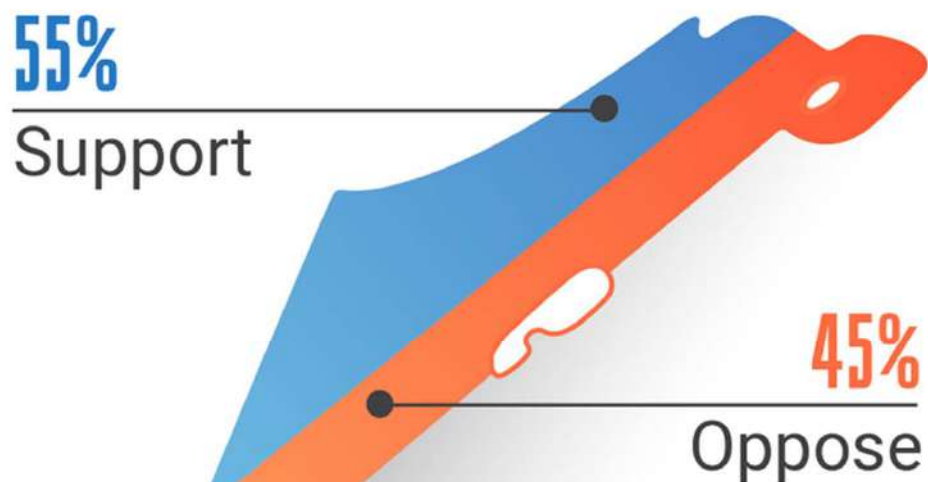

Do you support or oppose the solution of two states for two peoples?

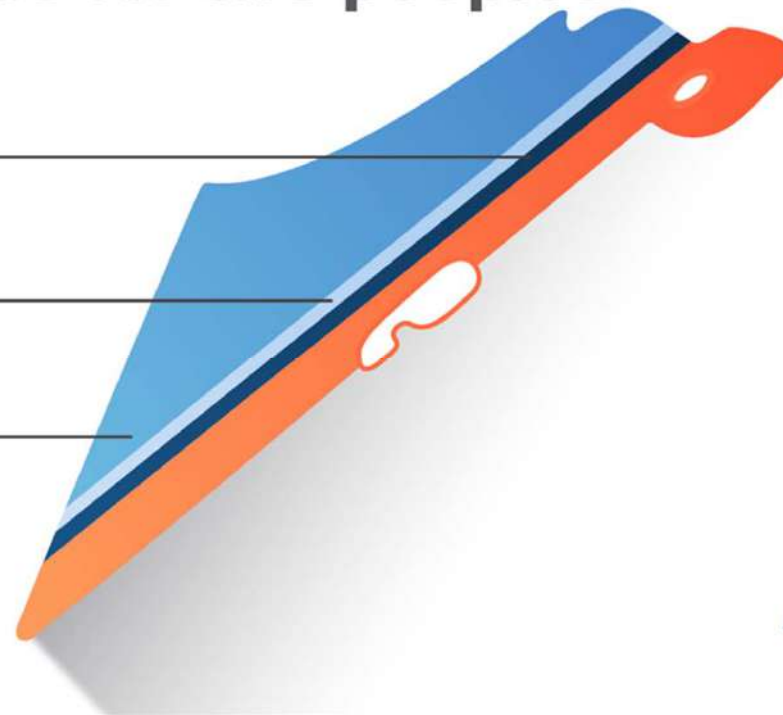

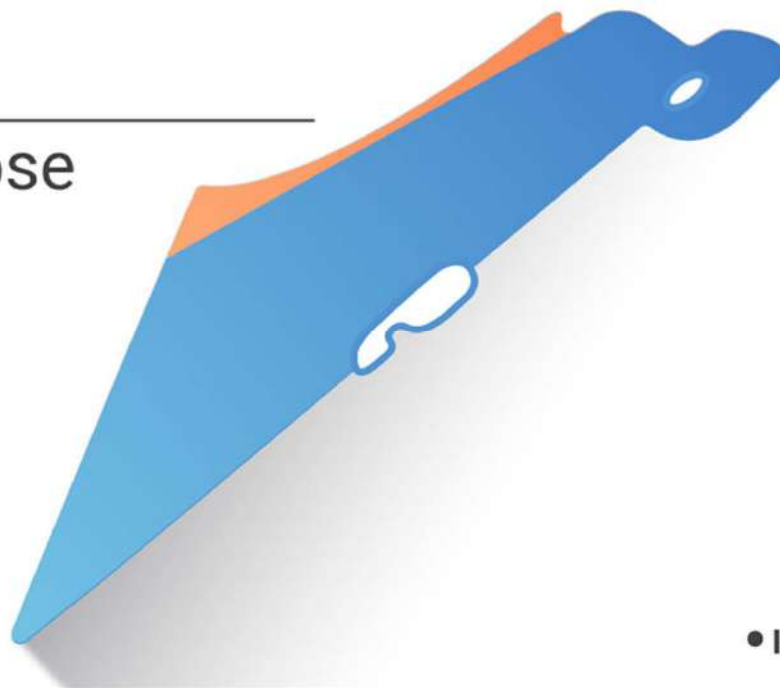

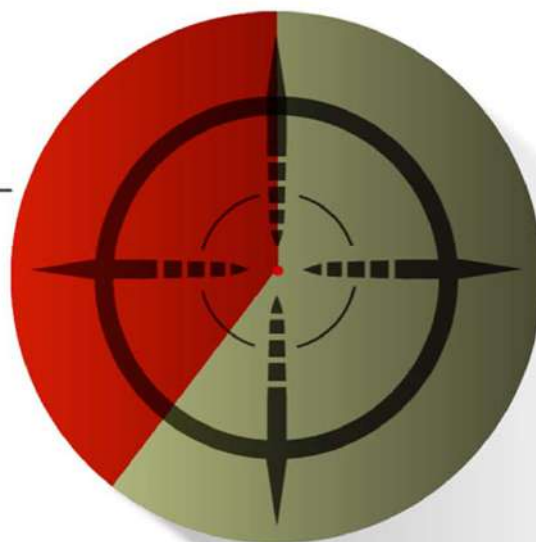

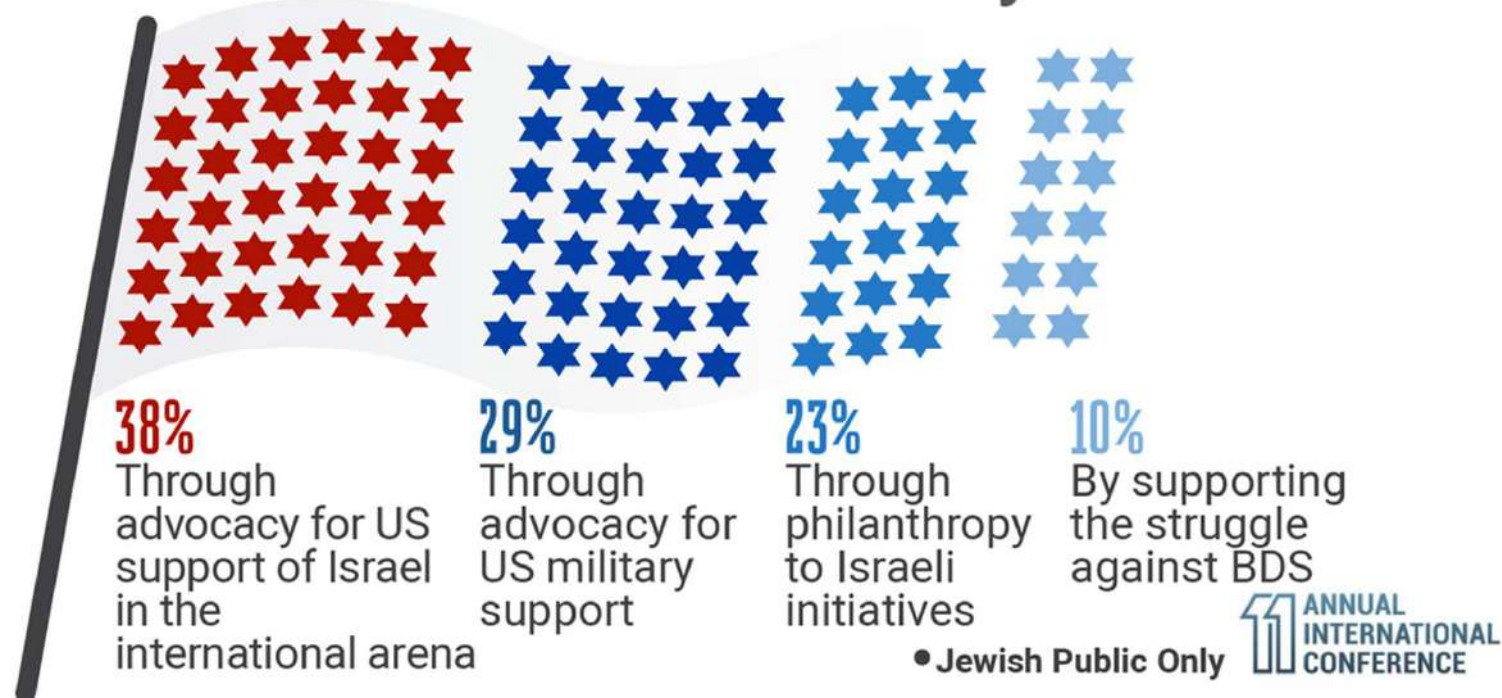

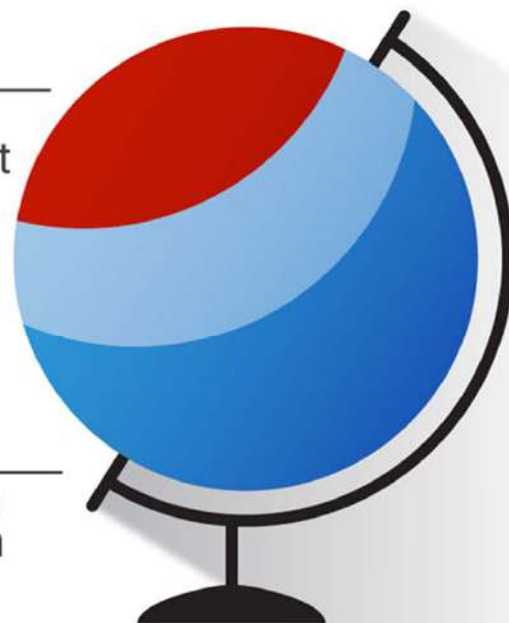

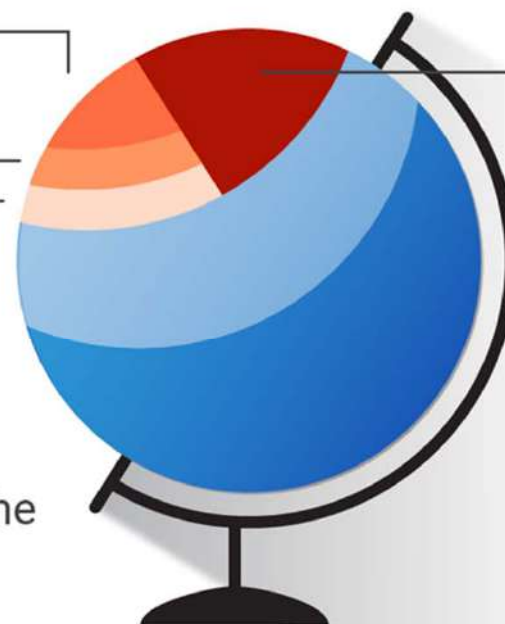
