The Plan's Objective

Guaranteeing the existence of the State of Israel as a Jewish, democratic, secure, and moral state.



The Urgency

Arresting the dangerous slide into a one-state reality.



The Key Principles

Combining negotiated, independent, and regional moves toward political, territorial, and demographic separation from the Palestinians; guaranteeing a high level of security; and demonstrating flexibility and the creative ability to change course at any time.



The Paradigm Shift

Shaping our destiny, and leveraging Israel's power to secure its future.

At this event, INSS will present the framework, which was formulated over the last year by INSS researchers, former senior officials in public service and the diplomatic and security establishments, and leading figures in the negotiations process.
