

## Former Health Ministry D-G Siman-Tov joins INSS as research fellow

Working alongside other senior INSS researchers, Siman-Tov will write policy papers that will be later presented to decision-makers.

Former Health Ministry director-general **Moshe Bar Siman-Tov** has joined the **Institute for National Security Studies (INSS)** as a research fellow, one of Israel's leading think tanks, according to a press release from the organization on Thursday.

Siman-Tov will lead research that examines the central role of the healthcare system within Israel's security apparatus. He will explore how a multidimensional crisis, including its economic, health, societal and leadership-related aspects, has managed under the current coronavirus pandemic.

Working alongside other senior INSS researchers, Siman-Tov will write policy papers that will be later presented to decision makers, in addition to the general public.
