Weakening Democracy Significantly Threatens Israel's Int'l Standing, Report Warns

The report connects the rising polarization and declining resilience in Israeli society to the recent political crisis, and warns that these issues and the risk they pose to Israel's international standing are significant threats

Deterioration of democracy due to Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu's new government, political polarization and the weakening of Israeli society's resilience pose some of the greatest short-term strategic threats to Israel, an assessment by the Institute for National Security Studies has found.

The report connects the rising polarization and declining resilience in Israeli society to the recent political crisis, and warns that these issues and the risk they pose to Israel's international standing are significant threats.

Israel currently "has a stronger military and international standing" than its external enemies, **Tamir Hayman**, **the managing director of INSS**, stated in the report. However, he warns, "2023 poses a host of challenges liable to upset this balance."
