

Morocco Could Renege on Commitments with Israel Due to Escalations in Palestine

Morocco has been walking a fine line, attempting to balance its rekindled relations with Israel with its support for the Palestinian cause.

Rabat - A report from Tel Aviv University's Institute for National Security Studies (INSS) has detailed some of the nuances behind Israel's recent recognition of Morocco's sovereignty over Western Sahara, including the possibility that Morocco goes back on some commitments with Israel as it continues showing support for the Palestinian cause.

Though the recognition is set to bolster the already rapidly advancing ties between the two countries, <u>the report</u> notes that there is a strong possibility that Morocco eventually goes back on some of its agreements with Tel-Aviv.

"This apprehension stems from Morocco's domestic and inter-Arab considerations, especially its longstanding commitment to the Palestinian issue, which garners significant popularity among many in Morocco and across the Arab world," the research explains.
