In a similar vein, <u>Pnina Sharvit</u>, head of the law and national security program at the amply funded think-tank the Institute for National Security Studies, <u>scolded</u>, "Israel should be extremely cautious about breaching the delicate balance between the Jewishnationalist component and the democratic-liberal component of its essence, as enshrined in the Declaration of Independence."

Likewise, the president of the distinctly left-leaning Israel Democracy Institute, cherry-picked words from the Declaration, asserting, "The Declaration of Independence expresses a deep commitment to freedom, justice and peace in the spirit of the vision of the biblical prophets."
